Dear Pastor,

We are writing to ask you to consider supporting the Lakeland Bible School.

We are aware that many of our young people are in small fellowships with minimal contact with other young believers in similar situations.

It was out of a concern for young Christians in this kind of situation that the Lakeland Bible School began. It was modelled on the Whitby Bible School (www.septemberbibleschool.org.uk) but focused on seeking to help young Christians in Cumbria and the North West area, though young people wishing to come from further a field are welcome.

The venue is very attractive – Keswick – right in the heart of the Lake District in the shelter of beautiful fells and next to Derwentwater with its picturesque islands and boats.

The first Bible school met in 2004 based in the Congregational Church on Lake Road. More recently with increasing numbers we have moved to the facilities of the Keswick Convention centre where all the young people can fit into the one venue.

There are usually about 40 young people staying for the weekend for a mixture of bible study and recreation. There are a mixture of main sessions with smaller seminars and fellowship groups with the Saturday night Q&A session always being appreciated by the young people.

The 2010 School will take place from the evening of Friday 18th June and finish during the afternoon on Sunday 20th June. Our main speaker for this year is Phil Heaps from Grace church Westerleigh. In addition there will be a session led by Mick Lockwood and Nathan Javed from the Hall Green Chapel in Howarth. A variety of speakers from the area have been invited for the seminars.

You would be able to support this work by encouraging any young people in the 16-30 age range to come to the Bible School.
